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Governor Scott Proclaims March Florida Bicycle Month

Tallahassee – Governor Scott signed an official proclamation recognizing March as **Florida Bicycle Month**. Bicycling plays an important role in providing transportation to work, school, for fitness and recreational activities to millions of Florida residents and visitors annually.

Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) Secretary Jim Boxold said, “Florida Bicycle Month encourages people to be active and ride their bikes. Because it is important to have a safe transportation system for everyone, including bicyclists and pedestrians, the department has adopted a Complete Streets policy. This initiative allows all road users to coexist and share the road safely.

The Florida Department of Transportation is committed to reducing crashes, fatalities, and serious injuries involving pedestrians and bicyclists.

“In Florida, more people are cycling than ever before.” said Trenda McPherson, FDOT State Bicycle Pedestrian Safety Program Manager. “The people on bikes are often children, neighbors, friends, and co-workers, so remember to give them space and keep them safe.”
