Complete closure of Currie Road for drainage work

Palatka – Currie Road in San Mateo will be completely closed Thursday through Tuesday at U.S. 17 for drainage work. Access to Currie Road will be maintained at State Road 100. The detour will be signed.

The closure is required to install drain pipes within the existing roadway. Access for residents only will be maintained, and the road will open early if work is completed ahead of schedule.

This work is part of the ongoing two-mile long project to widen U.S. 17 to four lanes from State Road 100 in San Mateo to Horse Landing Road in Satsuma. Construction also includes building a 12-foot-wide bike and pedestrian path on the eastside of U.S. 17. The \$13.8 million project by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to be complete by late 2017.

FDOT urges caution while driving through construction zones. The speed limit has been reduced to 45 miles-per-hour throughout the project limits for the duration of work. Speeding fines are doubled in construction zones when workers are present.
