Lane closures and ramp detour planned on State and Union Streets and on Mathews and Martin Luther King Jr. Expressways

Jacksonville – Daytime and nighttime lane closures on Union Street and State Street are planned Wednesday and Thursday as part of a Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) resurfacing project. In addition, nighttime lane closures and a ramp detour are scheduled on the Mathews Expressway and Martin Luther King Jr. Expressway.

Daytime lane closures are scheduled from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. on Union Street from Lee Street to Madison Street and from Hogan Street to Liberty Street for construction activities including curb and sidewalk demolition and traffic signal work. Nighttime lane closures are scheduled from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. on Union Street from Laura Street to Main Street for installing a water main. Nighttime lane closures are scheduled from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. on State Street at Pearl Street for drainage work.

The ramp from westbound Mathews Bridge to northbound Martin Luther King Jr. Expressway is scheduled to close each night from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Detour signs will be posted directing traffic to continue westbound Mathews Expressway to exit and re-enter eastbound Mathews Expressway traveling to northbound Martin Luther King Jr. Expressway. Also, nighttime lane closures on both expressways will be in effect.
