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## **FDOT hosts public meeting to discuss replacing bridges in Starke on US 301 and in Lawtey on CR-200A over Alligator Creek**

*Starke* – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is hosting a public meeting April 12 from 4-6:30 p.m. at the Bradford County Library, 456 Pratt Street, Starke, FL 32097, to discuss a proposal to replace the U.S. 301/State Road 200 Bridge over Alligator Creek in Starke and a proposal to replace the County Road 200A bridge over Alligator Creek in Lawtey.

FDOT representatives will be available at the meeting to provide information and answer questions, but no formal presentation will be made.

The proposed bridge U.S. 301/State Road 200 Bridge over Alligator Creek in Starke will have two 12-foot travel lanes, five-foot bike lanes and six-foot sidewalks in each direction. Because the bridge is connecting to roadway sections that do not accommodate bike lanes, bike lanes will not currently be provided beyond the bridge transitions.

During construction, traffic will be reduced to two-lane, two-way traffic. Anticipated completion of an Alternate Truck Route prior to the start of this project will help reduce traffic in the area.

The proposed County Road 200A bridge over Alligator Creek in Lawtey will have two 11-foot travel lanes and eight-foot shoulders. During construction, the road will be closed to traffic with a detour route established. Closing the road will allow construction crews to complete the work more quickly by not having to maintain traffic flow.

The average traffic along this section of U.S. 301/State Road 200 is 28,000 vehicles per day, and the average traffic along this section of County Road 200A is 650 vehicles per day.

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## **Jacksonville Area Road and Lane Closures for April 9-15, 2016**

### **Downtown Jacksonville**

#### **I-95 Overland Bridge project between Fuller Warren Bridge and Emerson Street**

Nighttime lane closures from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. from Park Street to Atlantic Boulevard for road work.

#### **I-95 southbound access road to Atlantic Boulevard**

Continuous road closure for roadway construction. Detour to Acosta Bridge, Museum Circle, San Marco Boulevard, Prudential Drive, Kings Avenue, Philips Highway and Emerson Street back to I-95.

#### **I-95 access road from northbound Philips Highway to Atlantic Boulevard**

The access road is temporarily closed. Detour is Kings Avenue which is modified to provide two-way travel between Philips Highway and Atlantic Boulevard.

#### **Atlantic Boulevard**

Daytime lane closures from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. from Kings Avenue to Old Hickory Road.

#### **Beaver Street between McDuff Avenue and Stockton Street**

The road is reduced to one lane in each direction for reconstruction.

#### **Canal Street at Beaver Street**

Daytime road closure Tuesday from 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. for concrete work. Detour is Westbrook Road and Line Street.

#### **Carrie Street from Broadway Avenue to Beaver Street**

Road closure Wednesday and Thursday for road construction and drainage work. Detour is Cone Street.

#### **Gary Street between Palm Avenue and San Marco Boulevard**

Continuous lane closures for bridge construction.

**Hart Expressway over Washington Street**

Daytime eastbound lane closure Tuesday from 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. for routine overpass maintenance.

**Hubbard Street over Hogan's Creek**

The road is closed between Orange and Confederate streets for a bridge replacement project. Detour is Market Street to Phelps Street.

**Kings Street between Canal and Danson streets**

Daytime northbound lane closures through Friday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. for utility work.

**Main Street Bridge**

Daytime lane closures Saturday from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. and nighttime bridge closures Sunday from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday and Tuesday from 6:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Wednesday from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., and Thursday and Friday from 6:30 p.m. to 6 a.m. to install temporary work platform. Detour is the Acosta Bridge.

**Main Street Bridge**

Daytime lane closures weekdays from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. to work on bridge lighting.

**McDuff Avenue just north of Beaver Street**

Complete road closure for road construction and drainage work. Detour is Beaver Street, Westbrook Avenue to Commonwealth Avenue.

**San Diego Road**

Complete nighttime road closure Tuesday through Friday from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. for bridge construction. Eastbound detour is Martin Street, Philips Highway, Atlantic Boulevard, White Avenue to San Diego Road. Westbound detour is Spring Park Road, Atlantic Boulevard, Philips Highway, Wishart Street to San Diego Road.

**San Marco Boulevard**

Nighttime lane closures Saturday from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. from Nira Street to Gary Street.

**Washington Street over Hogan's Creek**

The road is closed at the west end of the Arlington Expressway for bridge replacement. Follow detour route.

**Duval County****I-10 at U.S. 301 in Baldwin**

Nighttime westbound lane closures from 8 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. to install barrier wall.

**I-10 at Beaver Street**

Nighttime eastbound road closure Sunday from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. to set overpass beams. Detour is U.S. 301, Beaver Street, Chaffee Road back to I-10.

**I-10 over Cahoon Road**

Nighttime lane closures Monday through Wednesday from 10 p.m. to 4:30 a.m. for routine overpass maintenance.

**I-10 off-ramps to Lane Avenue**

Nighttime off-ramp lane closures Sunday from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. to install overhead signs. Detour is Cassat Avenue, Normandy Boulevard to Lane Avenue.

**I-10 from Lane Avenue to Cassat Avenue**

Nighttime lane closures Friday, April 8 through Monday from 7:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. for work on lighting and barrier wall removal.

**I-10 at State Road 23/Cecil Commerce Center Parkway**

Continuous inside eastbound and westbound lane and off-ramp lane closures in preparation for building new interchange.

Nighttime lane closure Sunday through Thursday from 8 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. for overpass work.

Nighttime westbound off-ramp closure to southbound State Road 23 Tuesday and Wednesday from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. for utility work.

**I-95 at Butler Boulevard**

Nighttime lane closures Sunday through Friday from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. for area maintenance.

Nighttime southbound off-ramp lane closures Sunday through Friday from 8 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. for road construction.

Nighttime northbound off-ramp closure Sunday through Friday from 8 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. to paint roadway markings. Detour is Bowden Road, u-turn to I-95 south to Butler Boulevard.

**I-95 over Lem Turner Road**

Nighttime lane closures Wednesday from 10 p.m. to 4:30 a.m. for routine bridge maintenance.

**I-95 from south of Old St. Augustine Road to the St. Johns County Rest Area**

Nighttime southbound lane closures Sunday through Friday from 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. for paving.

**I-95 from just south of Old St. Augustine Road to just south of I-95/I-295 south interchange**

Nighttime southbound lane closures Sunday through Thursday from 8 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. to install a temporary barrier wall and to paint roadway markings.

**I-295 East Beltway at Butler Boulevard**

Daytime northbound lane closures weekdays from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. for taking soil samples.

**I-295 West Beltway just north of 103<sup>rd</sup> Street**

Nighttime northbound lane closure Wednesday from 9:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. for road repair.

**I-295 West Beltway from Buckman Bridge to the I-95 South interchange (Express Lanes)**

Nighttime lane closures Sunday from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. to paint roadway markings.

**I-295 West Beltway just north of Commonwealth Avenue**

Nighttime southbound lane closures Sunday and Monday from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. for paving.

**103<sup>rd</sup> Street/Timuquana Road from Roosevelt Boulevard to Aviation Avenue at Cecil Commerce Center**

Temporary delays should be expected during nighttime slow moving operations weeknights from 2 to 5 a.m. for moving heavy equipment. Jacksonville Sheriff's Officers will stop and release traffic as the convoy passes.

**Atlantic Boulevard from Monument Road to Southside Boulevard**

Nighttime lane closures Sunday through Thursday from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. for road construction.

**Beach Boulevard from St. Johns Bluff Road to San Pablo Road**

Nighttime weeknight lane closures from 9 p.m. to 7 a.m. and daytime weekday lane closures from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. for landscaping the medians.

**Beaver Street between Halsema and Otis roads**

**Belfort Road at Butler Boulevard**

Nighttime southbound right turn lane closure to westbound Butler Boulevard Sunday through Friday from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. for concrete work.

**Butler Boulevard at I-95**

Nighttime on-ramp lane closures Sunday through Friday from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. for detour construction.

**Butler Boulevard from Philips Highway to Belfort Road**

Nighttime lane closures Sunday through Friday from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. for roadway and overpass construction.

**Heckscher Drive at Sisters Creek Bridge**

**Lane Avenue at I-10**

Nighttime northbound lane closures from I-10 eastbound on-ramp to I-10 westbound off-ramp Friday, April 8, Sunday and Tuesday from 7:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. and nighttime to daytime southbound lane closures Friday, April 8, Sunday and Tuesday from 7:30 p.m. to 11 a.m. for lighting work.

**Lane Avenue at Wilson Boulevard**

Daytime southbound lane closures weekdays from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. for concrete work.

**Lem Turner Road between Pine and Dunn avenues**

Daytime lane closures weekdays from 8:30 a.m. to 2 p.m. and nighttime lane closures weeknights from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. for drainage work.  
Continuous northbound lane closure to repair roadway damage.

**Owens Road between Yankee Clipper Drive and Fair Pine Lane**

The road is completely closed for road construction. Detour is Owens Road to Ranch Road to Airport Service Road North.

**Philips Highway from Old St. Augustine Road to just south of State Road 9B**

Daytime lane closures Tuesday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. for signal work.

**Philips Highway from Race Track Road to just south of State Road 9B**

Daytime lane closures weekdays from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. to paint roadway markings.

**State Road 23/Cecil Commerce Center Parkway at I-10**

Nighttime on-ramp closure Tuesday and Wednesday from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. for utility work.  
Detour is I-10, Chaffee Road exit to I-10.

**State Road 23/Cecil Commerce Center Parkway from 103<sup>rd</sup> Street to Normandy Boulevard**

Nighttime road closure Monday and Tuesday from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. for survey work. Detour is Normandy Boulevard, New World Avenue and 103<sup>rd</sup> Street.

**Clay County****Blanding Boulevard (State Road 21) from Allie Murray Road to Baxley Road**

Daytime northbound lane closures weekdays from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. for drainage work.

**Blanding Boulevard (State Road 21) from Baxley Road to Old Jennings Road**

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## **Main Street Bridge nighttime detour scheduled April 10-15**

**Jacksonville** – The Main Street Bridge will be closed to traffic Sunday through Friday nights to install a temporary work platform for the Florida Department of Transportation’s Main Street Bridge rehabilitation project.

Sunday and Wednesday the bridge will close at 9 p.m. and reopen by 6 a.m. the next morning. On Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday the bridge will close at 6:30 p.m. and reopen by 6 a.m. the next morning. Traffic will be detoured to the Acosta Bridge. Sidewalk access will be maintained at all times.

The mechanical, electrical and structural rehabilitation project includes replacement of several major mechanical components; however, an interim operating system will be installed to allow the bridge to remain operational while the mechanical work is completed. The project also includes replacement of the entire electrical control system. The mechanical and electrical components are essential to the operation of this movable bridge which occurs approximately 1400 times annually.

Other improvements include replacement of the traffic gates, sidewalk gates, lightning protection system, and closed circuit television cameras which give operators at the Regional Transportation Management Center (RTMC) live views of traffic conditions.

The temporary work platform being installed above the travel lanes and below the control house will minimize the need for lane closures, however, drivers should still expect intermittent daytime and nighttime lane and bridge closures for the duration of the project.

M&J Construction Company of Tarpon Springs is the contractor. FDOT’s \$10.7 million project is expected to be complete in spring 2017.

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
