
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Kings Road Union Street ramp and I-95 southbound Union Street exit closed Saturday and Sunday

Jacksonville – The Union Street ramp at Kings Road and the I-95 southbound Union Street exit (353B) will be closed Saturday at 6 a.m. through Sunday at approximately 5 p.m. for drainage work, weather permitting.

Eastbound Kings Road/Union Street traffic will detour to Myrtle Avenue, Beaver Street and Davis Street to Union Street. I-95 southbound Union Street traffic will use the Kings Road exit (353C) and follow the same detour route to Union Street (map below).

The work is part of the Florida Department of Transportation’s (FDOT) State Street, Union Street and Mathews Expressway resurfacing and improvement project. The \$13 million project began in December and is scheduled to be complete in spring 2017.





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Ramp closures next week for J. Turner Butler and Southside Boulevards

Jacksonville– The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will be making safety and traffic improvements at the J. Turner Butler (JTB) and Southside Boulevards Interchange next week, weather permitting. Ramp closures and detours will be necessary to update lighting for each ramp of the interchange.

Motorist traveling eastbound JTB to exit northbound Southside Boulevard will detour eastbound JTB, U-turn at Gate Parkway to westbound JTB and exit northbound Southside Boulevard Monday from 11 p.m. to 6:30 a.m.

Motorist traveling southbound Southside Boulevard to entrance ramp JTB eastbound will detour to Deerwood Park Boulevard to Gate Parkway back to eastbound JTB Monday and Tuesday from 11 p.m. to 6:30 a.m.

Motorists traveling westbound JTB to exit southbound Southside Boulevard will detour northbound Southside Boulevard and U-turn at Gate Parkway back to southbound Southside Boulevard Tuesday and Wednesday from 11 p.m. to 6:30 p.m.

Motorist traveling northbound Southside Boulevard to entrance ramp JTB westbound will detour eastbound JTB and U-turn at Gate Parkway back to JTB westbound Wednesday and Thursday from 11 p.m. to 6:30 p.m.

Message boards will inform motorists of detours in advance. The average number of vehicles traveling on the ramps each day ranges from 3,200 to 7,400. FDOT hired Duval Asphalt Inc. to complete the \$1 million project by late fall, weather and schedule permitting.
