## Escambia and Santa Rosa County Traffic Alert

---

**Chipley**– Drivers will encounter traffic disruptions on the following state roads in Escambia and Santa Rosa counties as crews perform construction and maintenance activities.

- **State Road (S.R.) 95 (Century Boulevard), Escambia County**- Southbound outside lane will be closed from 5 p.m. to 6 p.m. Saturday, Dec. 19 for the Century Christmas Parade.
- **S.R. 289 (9th Avenue), Escambia County**- Crews will pave between Bayou Boulevard and Creighton Road Saturday, Dec. 19 and Sunday, Dec. 20. Lane closures will be in effect from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Drivers will encounter daytime and nighttime traffic disruptions on the following state roads in Santa Rosa County as crews perform striping and pavement marking operations. Saturday, Dec. 19, Monday, Dec. 21 and Tuesday, Dec. 22.
  - U.S. 90 just east of State Road 281 (Avalon Boulevard) to S.R. 87 and west end of Blackwater Bridge to the east end of Blackwater Bridge.
  - S.R. 87 (Stewart Street) from U.S. 90 to north end of Clear Creek Bridge.
  - S.R. 89 (By-Pass) U.S. 90 to S.R. 87.
  - S.R. 89 from S.R. 87 to County Road 178.
- **U.S. 98, Escambia County** – Westbound outside lane will be closed between North Tarragona Street to North Jefferson Street from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Monday, Dec. 21 and Tuesday, Dec. 22 as crews from ECUA perform utility work.
- **I-10 Widening, Escambia County**- The westbound right lane near the Scenic Highway overpass at exit 17 will be closed from 7 p.m. to 6:30 a.m. Monday, Dec. 21 through Dec. 23. as crews set beams for the new Scenic Highway overpass.

- **I-10 Widening, Santa Rosa County** – Alternating lane closures on Avalon Boulevard near the I-10 interchange from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday, Dec. 20 through Wednesday, Dec. 23. as crews perform bridge work.
- **I-10 Widening, Santa Rosa County** - Alternating lane east and westbound lane closures between the Escambia Bay Bridge and S.R. 281 (Avalon Boulevard/ Exit 22). Lane restrictions will be in effect from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday, Dec. 20 through Wednesday, Dec. 23.
- **Nine Mile Road, Escambia County**- Crews will close a portion of the eastbound right turn lane to Holsberry Lane from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Monday, Dec. 21 and Tuesday, Dec. 22 as crews make repairs to the roadway.

All planned construction activities are weather dependent and may be re-scheduled in the event of inclement weather.

## Okaloosa and Walton County Traffic Alert

---

**Chipley**– Drivers will encounter traffic disruptions on the following state roads in Okaloosa and Walton counties as crews perform construction activities.

- **U.S. 331 Choctawhatchee Bay Bridge, Walton County**- Alternating lane closures on U.S. 331 across the Clyde B. Wells Bridge in Walton County from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday, Dec. 20 and Monday, Dec. 21, from 7 p.m. to midnight Wednesday, Dec. 23 as crews place concrete for the new bridge.
- **State Road 123, Okaloosa County**- from north of Toms Creek to north of Turkey Creek will be reduced to one lane from 7 p.m. Tuesday, Dec. 22 to 6 a.m. Wednesday, Dec. 23 as crews place beams for the new bridge roadway. Traffic will only be allowed in one direction at a time. Flagmen will be on site to safely guide motorists through the work zone.

All activities are weather dependent and may be delayed or re-scheduled in the event of inclement weather. Motorists are reminded to use caution, especially at night, when traveling in a work zone and to watch for construction workers and equipment entering and exiting the roadway.
