Left-turn lanes on Caribbean Blvd. to close for two weeks at the Turnpike interchange  
Lanes will close around the clock beginning Monday, Nov. 2

FORT LAUDERDALE — Beginning Monday night, Nov. 2, the eastbound and westbound left-turn lanes on Caribbean Boulevard at the Turnpike interchange will close around the clock for approximately two weeks.

Traffic will be detoured as follows:

- Eastbound traffic wishing to turn left to get to Southwest 107th Avenue should take the Turnpike frontage road south to Southwest 211th Street/Cutler Ridge Drive, go east and then take the northbound frontage straight to Southwest 107th Avenue.
- Westbound traffic wishing to turn left to access southbound Florida's Turnpike should continue heading west to U.S. 1, go south to Allapattah Road, east to Southwest 211th Street and enter the southbound Turnpike.

The lane closures are needed as part of an ongoing project to widen the Turnpike from Southwest 216th Street/Hainlin Mill Drive to Southwest 184th Street/Eureka Drive in Miami-Dade County.

Electronic signs have been placed in the area to notify the public about the closures and detours.
