## Northbound Turnpike on-ramp from Griffin Road to close for 5 days beginning Dec. 3

FORT LAUDERDALE — The entrance ramp to northbound Florida's Turnpike from Griffin Road is scheduled to close for up to five days beginning at 9 p.m. Thursday, Dec. 3, transportation officials announced today. The ramp is anticipated to reopen by 5 a.m. Wednesday, Dec. 9.

The five-day ramp closure is needed for demolition of the remaining toll plaza facilities and ramp pavement reconstruction.

In addition, the ramp will also close between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. for two nights, Monday, Nov. 30, and Tuesday, Dec. 1, for toll equipment work.

Traffic will be detoured during the closures. Motorists should take Griffin Road or Orange Drive east to U.S. 441, go north to I-595 and then take the northbound Turnpike exit.

Electronic signs have been placed in the area to notify travelers about the closures and detours.
