**CLOSING - All Northbound Lanes on Florida's Turnpike North of I-595  
and the Northbound Turnpike Exit Ramp to Sunrise Boulevard**  
Closures nightly from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m., between Sunday, April 10 and Thursday, April 14

FORT LAUDERDALE — All northbound Turnpike lanes north of the I-595 interchange and the northbound Turnpike exit ramp to Sunrise Boulevard (Exit 58) will be closed nightly from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m., between Sunday, April 10 and Thursday, April 14. Northbound traffic will be detoured during these closures.

Two northbound Turnpike lanes will be closing one hour before the full closure begins at 11 p.m. Turnpike lanes will begin to re-open at 5 a.m., and all lanes will be open by 6 a.m.

- Northbound DETOUR – Drivers will be directed to exit the Turnpike at I-595, then travel east to US 441/SR 7 and north to Sunrise Boulevard. An alternate route is to exit at Griffin Road, travel east to US 441/SR 7 then north to Sunrise Boulevard. Please follow posted detour signs.

The exit to the I-595 Express lanes will be closed beginning at 10 p.m. In coordination with these closures, the eastbound opening of the I-595 Express lanes will be delayed until 5 a.m. on the mornings of Monday, April 11 through Friday, April 15.

These Turnpike lane closures are required while one bridge lane on Sunrise Boulevard is demolished. This work is part of the Turnpike's ongoing \$50 million project to modify and improve the interchange with Sunrise Boulevard.
